#### APPLY GOD'S WORD

- Imagine Abram, Sarai, and Hagar were in our Community Group.
  How would you counsel them, pray with them, and encourage them?
- 2. Can you relate to Abram and Sarai's frustration they believe God is not fulfilling His promise? When you're waiting on the Lord, how do you know when it is time to do something versus time to wait longer?
- 3. Reflect and connect Gen. 16 to the Gospel: How does Jesus so graciously hear, see, direct, save, and look out for us?

### TAKE A NEXT STEP

How would I answer, "Where are you going?" Is there a situation I'm trying to fix by myself instead of trusting the LORD? Are there issues of sin and hurt (between me and
