PREPARATION WORKSHEET

Passage:
1. How does the context inform the meaning of this passage? Please consider: a) the <i>literary context</i> (passages before and after the passage), b) the <i>historical context</i> (circumstances of the audience), and c) the <i>biblical context</i> (citations/allusions or historical connections to other books that the author is making).
2. How has the author organized this passage? Take time to a) show the structure in sections with verse references and b) explain what strategies you used to see this structure.
3. Drawing on your work to this point, state the author's aim for <i>his audience</i> (in one short sentence). What is the main point he is trying to make?
4. What parts of this passage connect to the gospel of Jesus Christ? What <i>part of the gospel</i> is in view?

5. Drawing on your work to this point, what conclusion will you argue to your audience (in one short sentence)? What applications will you make for your audience?
6. What is your sermon title and your preaching outline?
