Gear - Package will be available for order online. Athletes will only have to purchase CV gear they need. New CV Wrestlers will need a CV singlet, Hoodie, Pants and the long sleeve t-shirt.

Expectations - Expect everyone to be at every practice. We/Coaches expect communication when there is a conflict so I know why someone is not at practice or an event.

Grades -

Coaches receive a grade report each week during the season on Wednesday.

No Wrestlers are allowed to wrestle the following week if they have three D's or one F.

Wrestlers have until Friday of that week to get their grade up. If they are on the list of being ineligible and the wrestler can get their grades up, they must see CV AD, Scott Dowis, and show him proof that their grade has been raised.

Transportation for local tournaments and dual meets - Jess Ness has volunteered to put carpools together. If we don't have enough drivers for events, we will expect parents to figure out how to get their athletes to local tournaments, dual meets and JV tournaments. Historically we end up having only a handful of the same parents drive each week. Plan ahead, look at the schedule and figure out which dates you can drive, take off work etc to make it happen.
