## [Overview of the Network/Learning Outcomes](#)

The Data Visualization Network is an exciting opportunity for county office and district leaders to come together and learn about cutting edge, effective data visualization. Participation will build your capacity to effectively communicate your local context via data.

The focus for the learning will be [Stephanie Evergreen's online Data Visualization Academy](#), the cost of which will be covered by Sonoma County Office of Education. The nine network meetings will be devoted to sharing our work, learning from each other, and building our community of data focused educators.

This yearlong network will prepare participants to:

- Understand the foundations and research behind effective data visualization
- Create visualizations using Excel, R-Code, or Tableau
- Determine which visualization will most effectively communicate student needs and spark conversation to take action
- Learn with and from a cohort of data focused educators from other county offices and districts
