

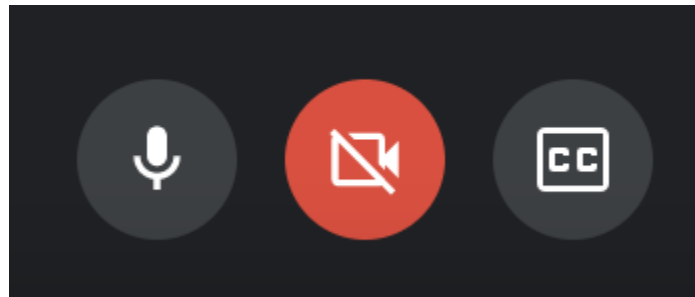
Supporting ESL students in the classroom using Google Meet

What the teacher needs to do:

1. Set up a Google Meet lookup link (ex. meet.google.com/lookup/mhermann)
Replace the last part of the link with your *first initial and last name*.
2. Post this link on your Canvas homepage via a link or the Meet Button.

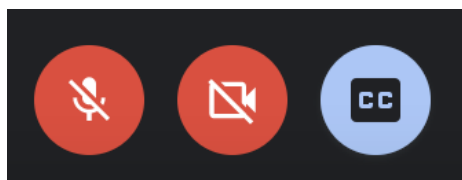


3. When class starts, start the Google Meet:
 - a. Turn off camera
 - b. Make sure microphone is on



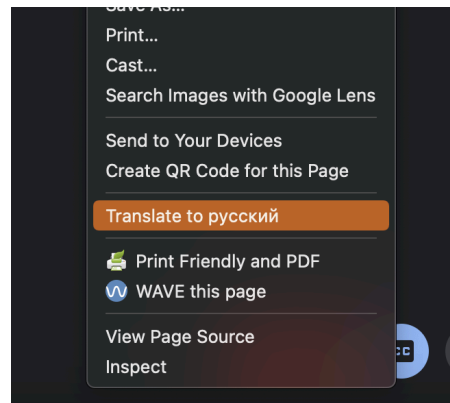
What the ESL student needs to do:

1. Login to Meet via the Canvas Home Page link provided by the teacher
2. Once the student is logged in, they should:
 - a. Turn off their microphone, camera, and mute their volume
 - b. Turn on closed captioning

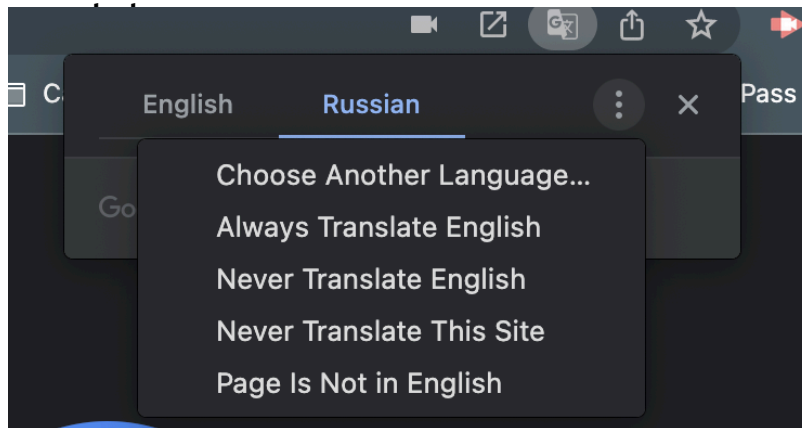


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3. To select the language to translate to, they should right click anywhere in the meet screen and select their language.



- a. If their language is not available, select what language is available, then click on the 3 dots at the top of the and select the language



4. The student can then follow along with the teacher. If the Laptop microphone is not picking up the teacher properly, use the Logitech Speakerphone Webcam provided to you last year for students on COVID-19 quarantine.
