Staff Speaker for Black History Month: Mrs. Justinger

- PBIS meets monthly for all of Parkview and some subcommittees to work on specific projects.
- Winter Bullpup lessons on playing behavior (playing in the snow and making sure that their gear is taken care of when coming in from recess)
- All Students received Bully Prevention lessons (4 total)
- How to recognize, report, and refuse to bully
- After the Spring break unit for in-person students will be focused on safe and personal space

- Virtual students are not participating in this curriculum due to the sensitive nature of the conversations and for student privacy
