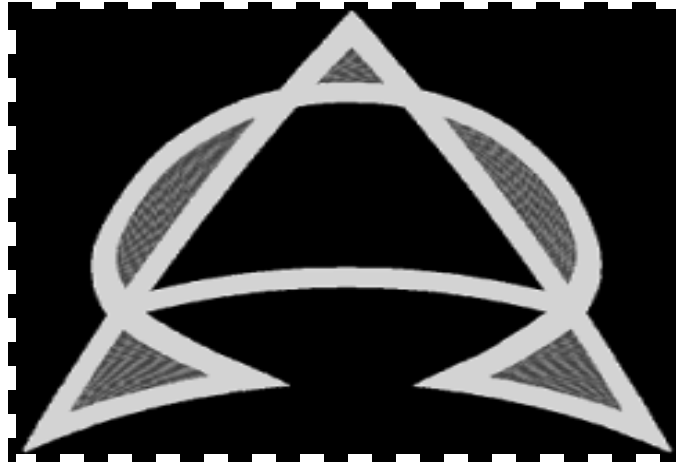




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Bermuda Omega

Bermuda Triangle

Overview

The legend of the Bermuda Triangle claims when you enter, you don't ever come back. That is because you enter our community, (Bermuda Omega) and forget about the outside world above. Our community is made up of a dome with 10 sections under it, separated by walls. These sections consist of 9 districts and the Capital. Each district has a main job (farming, mining, etc...). The resources are then used to power and sustain the districts and the Capital. The Capital is where the king lives and where he commands his underwater kingdom.

Government

Our government is a Monarchy and there are 9 districts that provide for the Capital. Each district does a certain job. After the job has been completed, the goods are teleported to the Capital. Then they are split into quarters. A quarter of the goods go to the Capital, and the other 3 are divided among the 9 districts. The king and queen make the laws based on recommendations from the royal people. These laws are enforced by tranquilizer dart bearing police officers so there is no death or long term side effects. When a person breaks a law their penalty is to work extra hours without pay. The amount of extra hours depends on the size of the crime.

The Laws of Bermuda Omega

- 1) No one may create their own business unless it is run under capital approval
- 2) No violence unless completely and utterly necessary
- 3) No lying to a government official
- 3) You may not spend the night at another's house
- 4) Curfew is set at 8:00 P.M.
- 5) You may not stay out past curfew
- 6) All food is accessed through the Mess Hall in each District. You may not store food in your house unless you bought it from the Mess Hall
- 7) To perform a new job you must first become certified in that field of work.
- 8) Don't take more than you need
- 9) No alcohol is permitted unless approved by the king
- 10) No rule should be broken

Education

The subjects we teach our citizens are math, ELA, biology, technology, and our community's history. The people need to know how to calculate crops and expenses plus the amount of hours that they work so they know what they have earned. They need to know how to read and write for most of the jobs and even for leisure. Some of the jobs require writing books to entertain or give information to the people. They need to learn biology and physical science so if they want to go into the medical field they have background knowledge. They learn more before landing a job. They need to know technology so that if something technologically malfunctions they know how to fix the problem. We only teach the people our history because we don't want them wondering about the world above. We are trying to keep our community as well populated as we can. Children from age 4 to 16 are required to go to school on a daily basis from 10:00 A.M. 2:00 P.M. and are required to do 20 hours of extra curricular activity every term. There are 2 terms. Each term lasts 50 days so students go to school for at least 100 days. Extra classes are provided. This is different from our community because we have to go to school from ages 4-18. We also take different subjects depending on our advancement in knowledge.

Family

Family in our community is different then the community we live in today. Families must live in the same district to eliminate the separation of families. You are allowed to choose your spouse but you have to date that person for a minimum of 4 years to reduce the chances of a divorce. In this community you are only able to be married once. Once married, if a couple want to have children, they have to take a test to make sure they will be good parents. Once you pass the test you are given the pill that allows you to have children. At birth babies are injected with a serum to prevent child-birth. If you or your partner do not pass the test you will not be given the pill and cannot make a child. Once you have a child you must keep that child. You are able to have up to three children. Both mother and father have equal power in the family and must consult with each other on major decisions. If the parents can not decide on an issue, their child, if above the age of 12, may make that decision, with parental approval.

Housing

The housing of our community is very different in different areas of the community. In the center of the community lies the Capital and the wealthy people such as the king and queen. On the outskirts of Bermuda Omega, the individual districts have small but well-maintained apartments. Between the Capital and the districts, there is farmland where there are small, simple houses for the farmers. All of the houses are different from each other except in the districts, where the apartments are very similar. All of the people of the Bermuda Omega community do not share houses with other families. The community has done very well to eliminate homelessness and poverty. All of the houses are very nice looking and not run down, and the owners of the houses take pride in how they look.

Money

The money system of our community is made of metal coins. There is no paper money. The coin's head has an omega symbol, representing the fact that Bermuda Omega is the last frontier. The tails side has Poseidon's trident and three stars on it. The trident represents the god Poseidon, whom the people worship. The three stars represent the three sides of the Bermuda Triangle. Copper coins are half an omega, nickel coins are 1 omega, silver coins are 5 omega, gold coins are 50 omegas, and platinum coins are worth 100 omegas.

Employment

1. Teachers- Our community needs to educate our citizens but in order to do that we need teachers. The women in the community are the teachers. Since there are 9 districts and 1 capital, we have 10 schools. Each school has 30 teachers. 6 teachers teach science, 6 teach social studies, 6 teach ELA, 6 more teach math and the final 6 are job specialists. This job earns 10 omegas per hour

2. Doctors- Our community needs to heal our citizens, so we have doctors. The doctors are chosen from the males in the community. We have 100 doctors in the Capital. The doctors work on cloning. The cloning makes new limbs for the people who are in accidents (they will NEVER know the difference). This job earns 50 omegas per hour.

3. Miners- Our community has a cave right next to it. We need miners to extract platinum and other metals from the ocean caves. The metals are then used for buildings, money and other building projects. The miners are among the strong men in the community. We have 50 miners, 10 going down each tunnel in the main cave. This job earns 75 omegas per hour

4. Searchers- Our community is underwater and we don't get a lot of guests so we have subs retrieve people from wrecks. Both women and men can be the searchers of the community. We hire up to 25 people for the job at one time. This job earns 75 omegas per hour

5. Utility Workers- Our community needs to run smoothly so we need to have lighting, heating, etc. (every community needs them). We hire 1,000 men and women to power the Capital and the 9 districts. The main power and other utilities will be located in the Capital but smaller buildings will be in the districts. This job earns 50 omegas per hour

Transportation

In our high-tech utopia transportation is vital to our communities ability to prosper, and move around. We are always relying on the ability to move around rapidly, because all time traveling is time wasted, since nothing is getting done. To resolve this problem of wasted time, our advanced community relies on teleportation to move from place to place without wasting a single second. Our advanced teleportation allows people and goods to travel anywhere in Bermuda Omega by breaking them down into molecules, and transmitting them across a radio signal to the location where they would like to go in their own community. The teleportation pads can teleport many people at once to where they would like to go. This reduces the time it takes for a mass of people to go to their jobs, and satisfy their needs.

Environment/Climate

Our thriving utopia is located in the center of the Bermuda Triangle off the coast of the tip of Florida (25.07, -70.9) . Each district and the Capital are surrounded by walls. Each district provides for everyone's needs, and the needs of communities that are struggling, or in need of certain supplies. There are no animals in our community, except in the science lab, where their meat is being cloned. Their milk is also cloned for consumption in all the districts. We have a warm semi-tropical climate across the whole utopia, where the weather never changes. The only exception is that it rains fresh water once a week in the vast farmland that cover all land between the districts. The farmlands have controlled moisture levels, that can be changed whenever it is needed depending on whether the crops are thriving or not. There are no pets, or animals, except those being used for food purposes, or experiments in labs. There are no pets or animals because they are unpredictable, and can cause unwanted pain, or sad feelings, such as when a pet dies. We have a large artificial "sun" that stays over the Capital, and turns off at night. It makes energy by boiling water and using its steam to turn several turbines and create lots of energy. This is located inside the "sun".

Recreation

In Bermuda Omega recreation is a must. Everyone is required to have at least 60 minutes of physical activity everyday to maintain ideal physical fitness. The only exception is for the elderly and infants. All children that are in school are given a half hour everyday during the school day that is unorganized "play time". During this "play time" they must decide on a game and make teams without any adult help however they are supervised by adults. This time is given for them to learn compromising and team building skills. Children are given the option to start sports at age 6. They can choose up to three different sports depending on the season the sports are played. The sports they can choose from are baseball (or softball), soccer, football (only an option for children above the age of 13), volleyball, track and field, and swimming. All children are taught how to swim for safety reasons. Less intense versions of sports are available for the elderly. Each district has there own recreational areas (parks), sports fields and pools. Each district and the Capital have adult sports teams that compete against each other at the Capital's recreational fields. Athletes are volunteers and do not get paid and they play because they love the sport, not for money. People from all districts are allowed to attend all professional games. Certain times will be set aside for these people to enjoy their sport, and support their district team.

Technology

Our community is more advanced than the world above. Our people came to the life of peace with our advancements of teleportation, artificial weathering and advanced underwater breathing domes. The major part of our technology will be the health of the community, and we have cloning so we can have a new way to heal people. We also use cloning with animals to gain a surplus in foods. We need to have fresh meat so everyone stays healthy. Our community has a special turbine design, the design make sure the community does not flood but gets enough water to power Bermuda Omega. These machines and more are what make the technology of the community advanced.

Additional Information

In our utopia there are nine districts plus the Capital. The districts are three mining district, three industry districts, three large farming district, each having a way into the Capital. In each district there is a teleportation device at the center to get to the Capital to receive healing, or do business. There are several teleportation devices around the farming district, that will teleport the farmers to their plot of land, and teleport them back after 10 hours. But there is also a normal teleportation device at the center of the farming district, used for the farmers health, and other needs. Most energy in Bermuda Omega is generated underneath the Capital. This is done by using a custom-made waterfall to turn many water wheels. This creates much of the utopia's clean energy which sustains the citizens, and is necessary for functioning of tools in their daily life. The teleportation system is used to teleport the water to the top of the waterfall to easily have a constant flow of energy.
