



Volunteer Opportunities

It takes assistance from everyone to make Beebe the best school!

Here are some ways to get involved with activities around Beebe. Everyone is welcome to participate! **Volunteers always needed!**

Art Awareness

No art experience necessary! Visit your child's classroom to teach about an artist/piece of art up 1-4 times per year. Artwork, supplies and lesson plans all supplied. Quarterly event that is scheduled with your child's teacher. Parents within a classroom can split up the presentations.

Beebe Garden

Help bring the Beebe Garden to life. Hard work culminates in the spring with students sampling fresh vegetables. This is a flexible commitment, great for parents with littles and/or parents that can't volunteer during the school day.

Beebe Has Heart

Plan and coordinate multiple service/donation efforts throughout the year, serving our immediate Beebe community, our local community, and the global community. May coordinate with Beebe Student Groups with similar projects (e.g. Bobcats on a Mission). Example: used crayon collection, coordinate donation drives such as school supplies, food/clothing collections, etc.

Beebe Adult Social

Help make the social event of the year a reality. Help with planning, event execution and gathering donations for auction.

Birthday Books

Help Mrs. Goff in the LC get a special birthday book for each student.

Communications

Work with the chair to develop social media posts for Facebook and Instagram. Assist with communication triage and occasionally help distribute flyers in teacher mailboxes. Time requirement is flexible and mainly done outside of school hours at home.

Cultural Enrichment

Work with a team to create a year round program to increase cultural awareness, education, and engagement. Help execute Passport to Culture event in the Spring.

Family Events

Help coordinate and run the Fall Outdoor Movie night and Spring Bingo. These events take place after school. Planning time is flexible, day of the event help with set-up and running the event is needed.

Fundraising Initiatives

Tasked with developing and executing strategies to raise money for the school. (i.e. Restaurant nights let parents take the night off making dinner while earning back money for Beebe at the same time! Assist committee chairs with distributing flyers at school and/or developing new restaurant contacts.

Fun Run

Help make our Spring FUN RUN a reality. Volunteers will help book a DJ, order t-shirts, develop a rewards system by grade and help organize the run.

Health Screenings

Volunteer to help at school for eye & hearing exams, etc.

Learning Commons

Volunteer in the LC shelving books and helping students find books.

Room Parties

Volunteer in your child's classroom at one of two parties during the year. Please indicate your child's teacher in the comments.

STEAM Night

Help plan and host the most electrifying night of the year! Assist the Chair with getting companies to participate, promote the event and host the evening.

Staff Appreciation

Plan a full week to recognize our amazing Beebe staff. Planning can be done at home and time is flexible. During Staff Appreciation week in the spring will need availability to be at Beebe before school to set up and afternoons for clean up.

Yearbook

Help design and publish the yearbook. Take pictures and gather pictures from families at school events.

Social Media

Collecting and/or creating Facebook and Instagram posts for events or activities from all committees. Occasionally create original content as well.

Staff Gift Card Program

Collects voluntary funds from Beebe families to purchase gift cards for staff in December and end of the year.

Spirit Wear

Looking for one or two people to maintain our relationship with our online spirit wear vendor and promoting any sales that happen throughout the year.
