

Strong students are able to organize their notes to prepare for an “On-Demand”, in class essay. . Often, powerful readers use tools to help them organize their ideas and prepare. Today you will do this as you create a MINDOMO linking different quotes from “Fences” to the unit question. First you will look at all your work and decide how you want to do this (tracing a motif or tracing beautiful quotes).. Next you will gather your work from your notes and put them into the Mindomo. Finally you will look at the Mindomo and explain how each text gave you a different point of view on the unt question. Next week we are going to turn these Mindomos into an outline that you will use for your in class essay.
