I wanted to reach out as we have entered the cold and flu season. All parents should want their children to try and go to school even if they are not feeling their best. OHLSD school's goal is to help kids self manage, and work through minor colds and allergies most of the time. If they show up to our office in the first hour, we will encourage them to try and do their best to make it until lunch, unless they have a fever or other issues. If your child has had vomiting/diarrhea/fever in the past 24 hours they should stay home and be free of it for a full 24 hours without medication before returning to school. This is because during that time they are the most contagious. We are here to help manage their health and wellbeing while at school.
