While in Principal Corps, I was on sabbatical from my former teaching position, serving as an administrative intern at Oxford Middle School and Della Davidson Elementary School in the Oxford School District. During the internships I had similar duties and responsibilities as an assistant principal.

AVID Site Coordinator, Oxford Intermediate School, Oxford, MS 2017-2020

Oxford Intermediate School adopted a school-wide approach to the AVID program during the 2017-18 school year. As Site Coordinator, I was responsible for ensuring the faculty and staff met the goals as written in the AVID Site Plan. I led a Site Team which met monthly. I also collaborated with teachers during PLCs and students as needed. During the first few months of implementation, Oxford Intermediate School was selected to pilot a new certification instrument. We were recognized as an AVID Elementary Certified Site for the 2019-2020 school year.

I taught gifted students in grades 2-8 while teaching in the Oxford School District. As a gifted teacher I was responsible for creating units of study based on the Mississippi Gifted Frameworks and Mississippi Process Skills.
