Rycor Digital Forms

- A parent raised a concern about digital permission forms via Rycor, noting some forms are not registering as submitted with teachers.
- This may be due to one of two reasons:

- When no fee is associated with the permission form, users must complete the transaction by checking out. Often, users add the form to their cart but do not finalize the transaction; Or—
- There may be a delay between form completion and receipt by teachers. Some teachers might send home a paper copy, assuming the digital form hasn't been submitted, when it is simply delayed.
