Social Studies Course Description:

Sixth grade social studies is a journey through world history. We start with the beginning of civilization and travel through ancient civilizations up to the Renaissance. Students will begin to understand the role that diverse cultures and historical experiences had on the development of the world.

Students will use in class handouts and interactive online notebooks to answer questions and take quizzes/tests. They will be responsible to complete their notebook as the teacher presents notes to them. They will have a copy of teacher notes up until quiz/test day. At that time, they will only be allowed to use the notes that they have taken to help them.

Each marking period students will be working on their geography skills. They will become familiar with using an atlas throughout each quarter. Their answers must come directly from the atlas that they are given. The skill that we are working on is using reference materials to find answers to specific questions. (No Google/Siri/or Alexa)

***At the end of the year, students will take a final exam worth 10% of their total final grade. Quarters 1-4 will be worth 90% of their total final grade.
