Update from the Officer at the Hospital

PC Mohammed Shami is currently at George Eliot Hospital, with the victim Matthew Tromans. The officer has been informed by Staff Nurse Yvonne Peters that Mr Tromans will need further treatment for the injuries he has received during the incident at the A444 lay-by. Mr Tromans has lacerations to his face and arms, possible broken ribs and a significant wound to his right shoulder. The shoulder injury may require surgery and the consultant is making an assessment at this time (0900hrs)

Mr Tromans has disclosed to medical staff that he ran through bushes at the side of the lay-by, as he ran off from his attackers, he had stumbled in the undergrowth and fell into a small ditch. As he fell, he felt a searing pain in his right shoulder. Initial medical assessment revealed a possible broken collar bone and this has been confirmed following X-ray examination. The consultant is finalising his assessment now.

PC Shami has not spoken directly with Mr Tromans at this time.
