Overview of Position:

The purpose of the NetworKIN committee is to strengthen and create connections within the UBC community and beyond. This committee will oversee (1) The Undergrad Buddies program, where lower-level Kin students will be paired with upper-level Kin students, placing focus on transfer students, (2) Faculty relations, where events and engagement with UBC KIN faculty will be a priority, and (3) UBC Campus connections, where opportunities and ways to get involved will be highlighted, and a focus on creating relations with clubs and other undergraduate societies will be placed. Overall, this committee is focused on creating connections and working to strengthen the relations within the KUS, the School of KIN, the UBC community, and external entities.

Responsibilities

- Overseeing the Undergrad Buddies program, where students will be paired with their peers based on goals expressed through their surveys, with an emphasis on supporting transfer students. One social event and asynchronous activities will be planned.
- Creating and maintaining relations with UBC KIN Faculty through the implementation of engaging student-faculty events and further collaboration.
- Sourcing UBC community-based opportunities for Kin students and creating connections with other UBC community student spaces such as clubs and undergraduate societies.
- Overseeing and running a committee.
- Attending a weekly meeting with the VP External.

- Ability to work independently and in a team
