Type your text here using Cambria 12pt font, 1.15 spacing, and in a single column. The Introduction contains the background of the problem in the research or research gap, and the position of the research among other studies on related themes to produce research novelty. You should also discuss the relationship between your research and that of other researchers; review the literature, especially the most relevant and recent academic works published in different journals, or find the state of the art. In addition, researchers also need to emphasize the focus of their research.

In the Introduction, you must answer at least two questions: (1) why your research is essential to answer; and (2) how your research relates to previous



research, and how your research contributes to the development of future research.

Method

Type your text here using Cambria 12pt font, 1.15 spacing, and in a single column. The method section includes the type of research, research time and location, target/objective, research subjects, procedures, instruments, data analysis techniques, and other matters related to the research method. Target/objective, research subjects, procedures, data and instruments, data collection techniques, data analysis techniques, and other matters related to the research method.

If the article is a review, the author may explain the methods used to obtain the review materials and how they were analyzed. In this subsection, there is no need to define the techniques used in detail; a brief and operational explanation is sufficient so that the methods used are easy to understand.

General Provisions

Articles must contain the author's original research findings or ideas that have not been published previously.

Page Setup

Articles should be typed on A4 paper with margins of 3 cm on the left, right, and bottom sides and 4 cm at the top, using *Cambria* 12pt font. For Arabic text, use *Traditional Arabic* 16pt font. The title should be in *Cambria* 16pt font. The manuscript should be at least 3,500 words and a maximum of 7,500 words (including the title page and reference list).

Subheadings

Each subsection in the Methods, Research Results, and Discussion sections is written sequentially with numbers 1, 2, 3, and so on, using 12-point bold *Cambria* font. If there are other subsections below, please write them as in the previous paragraph with bold text. If there are subsections from the previous subsection, use lowercase letters a, b, c, d, and so on.

Language

The entire article must be written in English, except for Arabic verses from the Quran and hadiths.

References/Citations

References/citations use the In-text reference style (last name, year) with APA (American Psychological Association 6th Edition) style, and including the page number of the citation is also permitted, such as: (Kartikasari, 2012) or (Kartikasari, 2012: 32), consistently applied throughout. Using that reference management software such as MENDELEY or ZOTERO is strongly recommended to be used.

Plagiarism Check

Submitted articles will be checked for plagiarism (maximum 20%) using plagiarism detection software, and further adjustments will be made according to the OJS management system.
