



Wasilla Youth Soccer Valley Revolution Uniform and Equipment Policy

Purpose

Wasilla Youth Soccer requires players to be properly equipped and dressed for all practices, games, and official events. This ensures safety, professionalism, and unity as representatives of the club.

Uniform Requirements

1. Game Uniforms

- Players must wear the official club-issued game jersey, shorts, and socks.
- Shin guards are required at all times during games and must be worn under socks.
- Soccer cleats (no baseball, football, or lacrosse cleats with toe spikes) are required.
- Goalkeepers must wear a jersey that distinguishes them from both teams and referees.

2. Practice Uniforms

- Players should wear designated practice gear or a plain athletic shirt/shorts if no specific practice kit is issued.
- Shin guards and cleats are required for all practices.

- Players should bring both a light- and dark-colored shirt for scrimmages, unless otherwise directed by the coach.

Equipment Requirements

- Each player is responsible for bringing:
 - Properly inflated soccer ball of the correct size for their age group (Size 3, 4, or 5).
 - Water bottle labeled with their name.
 - Any personal gear required (goalkeeper gloves, training pinnies, etc.).
- The club will provide team equipment (cones, goals, first aid kits, training tools, etc.).

Prohibited Items

- Jewelry of any kind (including earrings, necklaces, bracelets, watches, or fitness trackers) may not be worn during games or practices.
- Hard hair accessories (clips, barrettes, beads) are not permitted. Soft hair ties or headbands are allowed.
- Casts, splints, or hard braces must be approved by referees and/or coaches for safety.

Responsibility & Care

- Players are expected to keep uniforms and equipment clean, presentable, and in good condition.
- Lost or damaged club-issued uniforms/equipment may result in replacement fees.
- Equipment should be labeled with the player's name whenever possible.

Compliance

Players not in proper uniform or without required equipment may be withheld from participation until the issue is resolved.
