| Gear UP | We are continuing to provide push-in tutors to the algebra and pre-algebra classes, as well as walk-in tutoring sessions during advisory and lunch. GEAR UP is now providing a Project Based Credit Recovery Biology class for students who failed biology in the fall. There are currently 12 students enrolled, and 10 of the 12 are passing. (The 2 who are failing have missed more than 50% of classes this semester). We are continuing to assist students with scholarships and FAFSA by individual appointment and regular workshops (next workshop on Feb 2). On December 7, 33 seniors attended the "Cookies & Credit Scores" workshop. We are grateful to Nusenda for sending their employees to talk with our students and provide an engaging workshop!
