Please note that you must reapply each year. **Applications are due to the home school's principal by May 8, 2026.** *Newly enrolled elementary grades 1-5 applicants will be screened at their local CCPS school for math and reading.

*Grades 6-12 students must meet with the school counselor to discuss course offerings and schedules based on graduation requirements.

Student Expectations

1. Adhere to the *Code of Conduct* and *Acceptable Use Policy* while participating in virtual instruction.
2. Be available, as directed by the teacher(s), to participate in online learning activities on school days.
3. Participate each school day in every enrolled class.
4. Attend meetings at school, if required.
5. Seek help from the teacher as needed.
6. Complete and submit all lessons and assignments on time using a Campbell County Public Schools-issued device.
7. Communicate with your teacher and peers respectfully.
8. Ensure you can access online courses during school hours and complete assignments after school hours.
9. Acknowledge that the school division can access your schoolwork and comments posted within the online courses.

Parent Expectations

1. Ensure your child has the necessary internet access and the capacity to participate in online learning through Virtual Virginia.. The optimum requirements for internet speed are one device –6 Mbs download/2.5 Mbs upload; 2 devices-12Mbs download/5 Mbs upload; 3 devices 18 Mbs download/7.5 Mbs upload. 2. Provide your student with a safe and appropriate workplace at home.
3. Ensure that your student has sufficient time in his/her schedule to work each day on the scheduled courses
5. Encourage your child to seek help from the teacher as needed.
6. Ensure that your child completes all work and assessments without the aid of others.
7. Monitor your child's academic progress and ensure they attend live lessons, complete them, and submit all assignments.
8. Communicate academic concerns with teachers as necessary.
9. Communicate with the Homeschool and be prepared to have students participate in CCPS/State Assessments.

District Expectations:

1. CCPS will enroll your child in the Virtual Virginia Platform.
2. A mentor for each school will be assigned to oversee the virtual enrollment and monitor attendance and grades.
3. If the student has an active 504 Plan or IEP, the district will help determine whether the accommodations and support can be delivered virtually or modified through an IEP/504 meeting. For students with an IEP/504, team meetings with parents will be held to develop an appropriate plan. These accommodations will be communicated through the Virtual Virginia Platform.
5. Students who choose virtual school can participate in in-person extracurricular programs/activities if their schedule and academic success meet VHSL eligibility requirements.
6. CCPS will be responsible for administering state and local assessments. This schedule will be communicated to families so their children can participate in the assessment at the local school.

Students and parents fully acknowledge that success largely depends on the student's work and effort. **Students who fail to engage, fully participate, and are unsuccessful in the Virtual Virginia program may have their enrollment terminated and will be expected to return to in-person learning at their home school. The cost of Virtual Virginia will be billed to the parent if the student cannot meet the expectations of this agreement. The average cost of Virtual Virginia is \$250 per course(middle/high).**

Criteria for Acceptance:

- *Newly enrolled elementary K-5 applicants will be screened at their local CCPS school for math and reading
- *Grades 6-12 students must meet with the school counselor to discuss course offerings and schedule based on graduation requirements.
- In good academic standing, including grades, behavior, and attendance
- K-8 grade applicants must be reading on or above grade level and on track to be promoted at the end of the previous school year.
- Applicants for grades 9th through 12th must be in good academic standing, pass all classes, and be on track to graduate on time.
