Articles are made into page 1 column with A4 paper size. For Top Margin 3 cm, Left Margin 2.5 cm, Bottom Margin 1.5 cm, and Right Margin 1.5 cm. The manuscript was created using Microsoft Word, single-spaced, 10 pt Times New Roman, and no more than 8-10 pages.

Please select the title of the article with the least possible words needed to adequately describe the content. The introduction should describe the background of the study, the solutions offered and the related work that is comparable. if the article contains a citation, use [1], [2] and so on by using the Mendeley or Endnote citation tool in the IEEE format. Terms in foreign languages are italicized (italic).

It is recommended for Authors to use the following article structure: **INTRODUCTION (min 700 words), RESEARCH METHODOLOGY (min 500 words), RESULT AND DISCUSSION (min 1800 words), CONCLUSIONS (min 200 words)**. Maximum articles contain 6-15 pages.

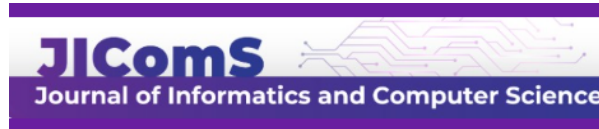


Fig 1. JComs Banner

All references cited in this article MUST BE ON THE CONTENT OF THE ARTICLE and MANDATORY to use reference tools such as MENDELEY with the IEEE format, 80% of the PRIMER literature (journals, proceedings, research reports, patents, standards, historical documents, research books) and 20% SECONDARY literature (books, trustworthy websites) within the last 10 years at least

The minimum number of references used is 13 references.
