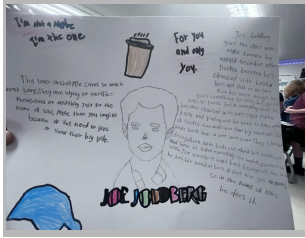

Connotation: I learned that connotation is between positive and negative words that the author chooses for a reason.
