WCCEdmentum Content in Canvas--Teacher Guide

Edmentum is vetted digital curriculum that we have access to for students and teachers. Students use it to gain new skills and recover credits. Teachers can use it as content for their traditional courses. This pre-made content can be easily put into Canvas courses.

Edmentum Access:

 Edmentum credentials are your school issued Google credentials plus an "Account"-- WCCC. John Reeder sets the Edmentum credentials up at the beginning of every year. If you are having difficulty with access, please reach out to John.




- The Edmentum website is https://www.edmentum.com/ Users can get into the Edmentum Courseware at this address OR
- Edmentum users can also launch into Edmentum through Canvas.

Edmentum Integration in Canvas:


At the beginning of the school year Edmentum is automatically set up for teachers in Canvas to use as an external tool.

- 1. In Canvas go to "Courses" or "Dashboard" and choose the course you'd like to assign the Edmentum.
- 2. Create a new assignment. Choose one method from the following:
 - Select "Assignments" from the white menu bar on the left. Click the blue "+ Assignment" button. Give your new assignment a title. OR
 - Go into the module where you would like to add the assignment and click the + and choose "Assignment" from the dropdown menu. Click on "[New Assignment]" and type the assignment's title in the box below and click "Save."
- 3. In the Rich Content Editor (RCE), give your instructions to students and establish assignment settings.
- Incorporate the Edmentum assignment into the Canvas assignment by going to "Submission Type" and clicking "External Tool."




- a. Click "Find."
- b. The "Configure External Tool" will pop up.
- c. Scroll to **"Edmentum Courseware."** All external tools are listed in alphabetical order.
- d. NOTE: This is the ONE external tool that we use that does not work like all the other external tools-- Google Assignments, Kami, Edpuzzle,


Nearpod, etc. The Configure External Tool Box WILL NOT pop up again. You will only see that a URL has been entered into the External Tool URL box.



- 5. Save your work. (You pick the Edmentum content AFTER the Save.)
 - a. Click the blue **"Save"** button to save the assignment as a draft (which won't be visible to your students) or
 - b. The gray "Save & Publish" button to make it available to your students.
- 6. Once the Canvas Assignment is saved, a window with all the "edmentum" or "Plato" content will pop up. You will need to drill down using the arrows into the offerings to find exactly what you need.



7. Once you pick **"Select"** it will ask whether you want to confirm the selection. Click **"Okay."**



If you ever get the following "Unauthorized" notice after confirming your content selection, refresh the assignment. It should automatically fix the problem by logging you into Edmentum . You shouldn't see this pop up, but rather a preview of the content you selected. If it doesn't fix itself after refreshing the assignment contact Winnie.

Edmentum in Canvas Troubleshooting & Tips:

1. If you ever get the following "Unauthorized" notice after confirming your content selection, try refreshing the assignment. It should automatically fix the problem by logging you into Edmentum. When it is working, it should direct you to a preview of the content you selected. If it doesn't fix itself after refreshing the assignment contact Winnie for troubleshooting help.

- 2. If you accidentally inserted the wrong content go back to the Canvas Assignment, at this time you can't delete the connection to the wrong assignment.
 - a. You will need to start over. Because of a design flaw, you can't delete that link even if you save the assignment as a different submission type and then go back to external tool, it still finds its way back to the wrong Admentum asset. Boo!
 - b. As a result, it is highly recommended that you preview all Edmentum content BEFORE clicking okay to "Confirm Content Selection."

Advantages for Incorporating Edmentum into Canvas:

- 1. Quality premade content that can be added easily
- 2. The content is presented in a consistent format as your more traditional classes.
- 3. Students' progress can be reflected in the Canvas gradebook.
