

MINUTES OF THE EAST UNION COMMUNITY SCHOOL
BOARD OF DIRECTORS PUBLIC FORUM
March 27, 2024

The Public Forum was called to order by Board President Adam Tallmon at 6:30 pm in the Collaborative Learning Center. Board members Amber Tate, Jamie Buffington, and Carol Eckels answered roll call. Sam McKnight was Absent. Superintendent Tim Kuehl and School Business Official Rhiannon Tessum were also present.

Eckels motioned to approve the agenda, which was seconded by Tate. The motion passed unanimously with a vote of 4-0.

The president announced the commencement of a hearing on the proposed school calendar regarding a four-day school week. Superintendent Kuehl presented over the latest community, staff and student survey results. East Union Early Childhood Center Director Peggy Hardy presented on the plan on the “5th day” school age childcare plans if the 4-day school week were to happen. Numerous individuals appeared on behalf of the school calendar, including Jason Riley, Jean Kinyon, Gary Clear, Vickie Paulus, Jim Findley, Meggen Roan, and Jake Roan. Discussion ensued regarding the proposed changes and community survey. Subsequently, the president declared the hearing closed.
