Dear Cotter Families,

Upon participation in Cotter Athletics and attendance at Cotter Athletic events, it is the expectation to follow Cotter's Code of Conduct.

Our Code of Conduct is grounded in our core values of respect and community, and the expectation is simple: enjoy the games and support our athletes in a positive manner. We offer these guidelines:

- Be good role models
- Respect officials, coaches, athletes, parents, staff, game personnel, and fellow spectators
- Use positive, appropriate language at all times
- Move safely through indoor and outdoor facilities, including the lobby and hallways (No horseplay or rough behavior)

Parents, families, and guests play a major role in helping us reinforce these expectations and maintain an environment that feels fun and safe for all.

A few reminders for students and parents:

- Students must remain in permitted areas only, while maintaining a safe distance from the playing surface: the bleachers, the gym, lobby, and restrooms
- Students in grade 6 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
- Students who cannot follow the Code of Conduct will be asked to sit with their parents or be picked up.

Our site supervisors and staff work hard to keep these events running smoothly and safely. Please support their efforts. Your partnership helps create an atmosphere where our athletes can compete with pride and our community can enjoy the experience together.
