

Parents,

If you have a child entering 7th or 8th grade for the 23-24 School Year and they require medication while at school a **new** medication administration form needs to be completed by your child's physician and brought to the school nurse along with the medication that will need to be given. The medication administration form must be completed before your child can receive medication at school.

If your child has asthma, diabetes, seizures, or a severe allergy/anaphylaxis, a **new action plan** will need to be completed by your child's physician along with a medication administration form if your child will need medication at school to manage their condition. It is required that a **new** medication form/care plan is filled out for every new school year.
