
ChoCho

nCo or CoCo

- Chocho is a marking that resembles the markings on butterfly wings.
- The pattern can follow the same general theme or be all over the place with markings and designs.
- The designs should still not be too shaped like any particular object hearts, flowers, etc...
- Chocho is always black or darker than the base.


General:

3-15 small markings on the body.

Larger areas of pattern show up








VARIANT EXPRESSION:

Shows only on the shoulder of the furred part.



WITH SECONDARIES:


- ☑ You can fill half and blend it the rest of the way
- ☑ You can fill areas (but not the whole marking)
- Do not fill the marking itself
- Do not outline the outside of the marking
- Do not make areas where the secondary is making markings by itself.
