

## **ChoCho**

nCo or CoCo

- Chocho is a marking that resembles the markings on butterfly wings.
- The pattern can follow the same general theme or be all over the place with markings and designs.
- The designs should still not be too shaped like any particular object - hearts, flowers, etc...
- Chocho is always black or darker than the base.

### **DENSITIES:**

#### **Sparse:**

3-15 small markings on the body.



**Low:**

Larger areas of pattern show up

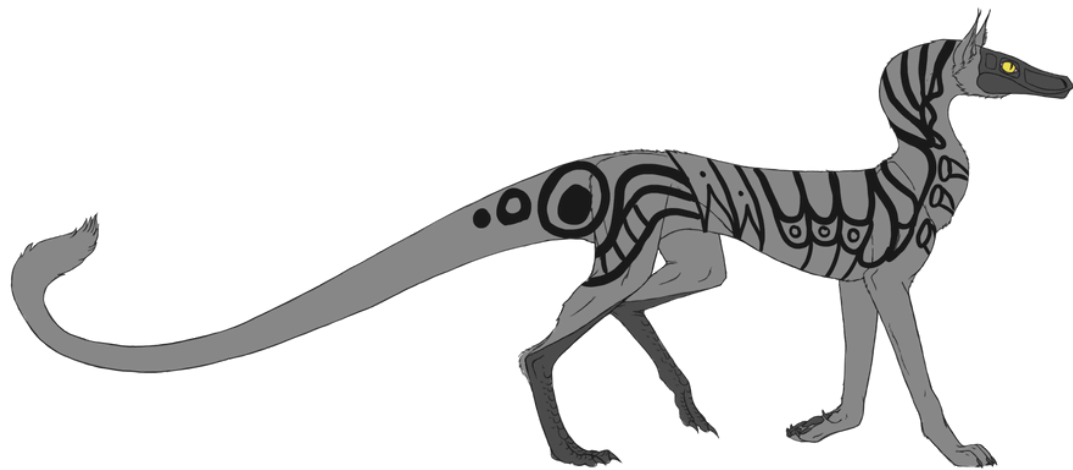


**SPREAD:**

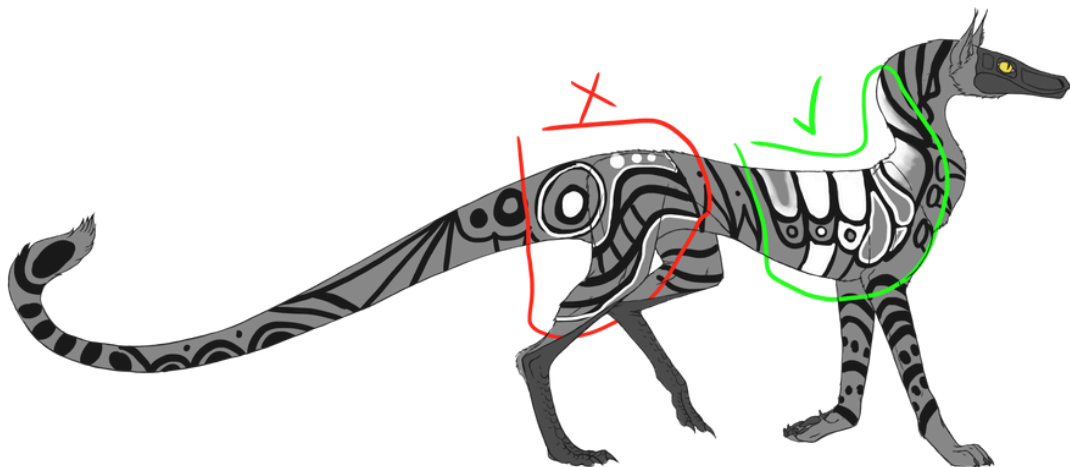
**VARIANT EXPRESSION:**

Shows only on the shoulder of the furred part.



### WITH SECONDARIES:

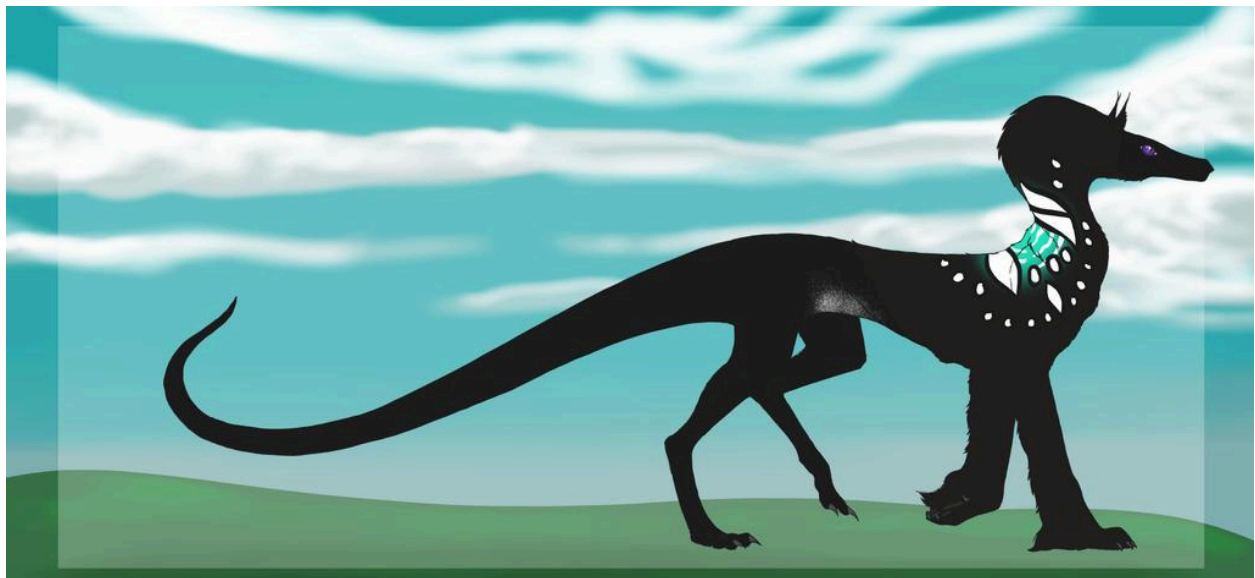
- ✓ You can fill half and blend it the rest of the way
- ✓ You can outline the inside, outline and blend as well
- ✓ You can fill areas (but not the whole marking)
- ✗ Do not fill the marking itself
- ✗ Do not outline the outside of the marking
- ✗ Do not make areas where the secondary is making markings by itself.
