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1. What is Laudato Si' Week?

Laudato Si' Week (May 17–24, 2026) is a global moment when Catholics around the world come together to **turn hope into concrete action for our common home**.

For 2026, in coordination with the Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development and Catholic leaders and communities worldwide, this week invites:

One week. One action. A shared global response.

Through the **Laudato Si' Action Platform**, these actions become part of a visible, collective expression of the Church's commitment to integral ecology.

2. Campaign Focus (2026)



Core call to action: During Laudato Si' Week: **Take one concrete action** for integral ecology and **document it** through **the Laudato Si' Action Platform**

What makes 2026 unique:

- A **shared global moment of action**
- A focus on **one concrete step**, not long-term planning
- A unified effort to **make the Church's response visible**

3. Our invitation for Partners

Partners are essential in:

- Mobilizing their communities to participate
- Helping people choose one action
- Directing participants to the Laudato Si' Action Platform
- Amplifying the sense of global participation

You are not expected to create complex programming. Our hope is to help people take one step and join a shared, cohesive moment.

4. Possible Partner Activities

Partners may:

- Share campaign emails or newsletters
- Post on social media
- Highlight 1–2 example actions
- Encourage reflection in parishes or groups
- Attend the [Creation Care Commissioning](#)
- Organize a small event (optional)

The goal across our networks is not activity volume, but clear invitation and participation.

5. How the Platform Works (Simple Explanation)

- Enroll on <https://laudatosiweek.org/> or <https://laudatosiactionplatform.org/register/>

After enrolling:

- Participants answer a short 2-minute set of questions
- They receive personalized suggested actions



- They choose one action
- After completing it, they mark it on the platform

This allows their action to become part of the Church's global response.

6. Suggested Timeline for Laudato Si' Week 2026

The following timeline is offered as a simple guide that partners may find helpful as they accompany their communities toward Laudato Si' Week. Each context is different, so feel free to adapt this rhythm in a way that best serves your community.

April 15 – April 30

Begin introducing Laudato Si' Week and inviting people to reflect on one action. Share the dates of Laudato Si' Week. Begin inviting people to reflect on what action they might take

May 1 – May 10

Help people take a first step by sharing the platform and simple action ideas. Some partners may choose to introduce the Laudato Si' Action Platform as a tool, invite people to explore suggested actions, and share a few simple, practical examples

May 11 – May 16

Encourage participants to choose their action and prepare for the week. Build a sense of shared anticipation.

May 17 – May 24

Laudato Si' Week: accompany actions and share stories of participation. Highlight the sense of global participation

May 23

During the week, the Creation Care Commissioning offers a special moment of unity and sending forth within the Church. Invite communities to register [here](#).

May 25 – May 31

Invite participants to mark their action and share the fruits of the week.
