- IESA Sectional Bowling Tournament held on April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2026
- IESA State Bowling Tournament held at the Town and Country Lanes in Joliet on Friday and Saturday, April 17<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup>

**Requirements: Please carefully consider these requirements before choosing to sign-up for this activity. All of these requirements must be met, including attending the Conference, Sectional, and State Tournaments, should the student earn the opportunity to represent our school.**

- Students must be committed to attending all practices. Transportation will be provided to and from Poplar Creek Bowl (2354 W. Higgins Road) in Hoffman Estates. However, parents will either need to pick up their child at the bowling center no later than 5:00 p.m. after each practice (5:30 on the Tuesday and Friday practices) or at Prairie Campus once the bus returns at approximately 5:15 p.m. (5:45 on the Tuesday and Friday practices)
- Students must be available to participate in the Conference, Sectional, and State Tournaments if selected and provide their own transportation to and from the tournaments. The school will fund the entry fees for the Conference Tournament and State Series.

- Students are required to have a current physical on file with the school nurse.
- Students should be in good standing by:
  - Maintaining passing grades in all classes
  - Demonstrating satisfactory behavior
  - Displaying positive attendance patterns
  - Participating fully in P.E. Class
