## Russell McDowell Intermediate School 5th GRADE SCHOOL COUNSELING SCHOOL-WIDE CORE CURRICULUM ACTION PLAN 2025-2026

- 1. **Attendance:** I will reduce at-risk students (students who missed 7+ days of school in the previous year) by 45 percent during the 2025-2026 school year through providing targeted interventions.
- 2. **Academic**: By October 2025, the number of 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students scoring novice on the K-PREP test in reading will decrease by 12%.
- 3. **Personal:** 80% of students in grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> will end the 2025-2026 school year with 0 office referrals due to behavior. Those students that received 2 or more office referrals will decrease by at least 10% for the 2025-2026 school year.

\*Mindfulness will be taught school-wide and in Counseling Classes throughout the year.
