2. Choose Apply for **Fall 2022**
3. Select Create an account (Complete the following sections)

  - ☐ Username and Password (Your username must be at least 6 characters. Your password must be a minimum of 8 characters and contain at least one letter and one number or special character), ***Be sure to email your username and password to yourself.***

10. Click on High School Coursework (2<sup>nd</sup> bar from the top on the left side of the page)
11. Click on grade level bar and choose Grade 9
12. Apply Online for **Fall 2022**

**Release Statements** –I recommend that you check all three, but DEFINITELY check the first 2.

**Dates of Attendance** for students who have been at BHS since freshman year are:

**08/2018 to 06/2022**

The **Student State ID** (SSID) is the 10-digit number listed near the top of your transcript.

If you have taken, or will take the SAT or ACT, but don't have your scores yet, input the Test Date and leave the score section blank.

SAT and ACT are no longer required for CSUs or UCs.

FOR CSUs ONLY: \*\*When listing courses, do **NOT** list any courses with "D" or "F" grades **IF** you have taken the same course over and received a passing grade ("C" or better). Just list the passing grade for the year you retook the class.\*\*

DO NOT TYPE in names of classes you have taken at BHS.

**ALL BHS CLASSES SHOULD BE CHOSEN FROM THE EXISTING PULL-DOWN MENUS!!**

**(U9) 9<sup>th</sup> Grade:**

History: - Global Studies

English: - English 1A/1B

Math: - Use Math 1 or Advanced Math 1

If you took Math 1 or Adv Math 1 in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade, also enter Algebra 1 under 8th grade, but list your grade in the class for both semesters as Pass. It will show up as occurring during your 9<sup>th</sup> grade year

Science: - Physics 1

World Language: Follow the titles from your transcript.

If you started with Spanish 3/4 in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade, enter both Spanish 1/2 and Spanish 3/4 in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade. For the Spanish 1/2, enter both semester grades as Pass.

**AMPS 10<sup>th</sup> Grade:**

History:  
- World History and Cultures 1/2

English:  
- World Literature A,B

Math: - Use Math 1 or 2 or Adv. Math 1 or 2

Science: - Chemistry

World Language: Follow the titles from your transcript.

Art: Varies

**AMPS 11<sup>th</sup> Grade:**

History: - U.S. History

English: - Literacy, Advocacy and Public Service: Advanced English in Public Service Work  
(State the class is Honors, both fall and spring)

Math: - Use Math 1, 2 or 3 or Adv. Math 1, 2, 3

Science: - BioHealth Science  
- Biotech 1/2 is called Biotech 1/2

World Language: Following the title on your transcript

College Prep Elective: - Community Service: A Sociological Perspective for ROPComServProf

**AMPS 12<sup>th</sup> Grade:**

History: - American Government (1<sup>st</sup> semester grade = "In Progress", No 2<sup>nd</sup> semester grade)

English:

- Reading and writing your way to a healthier world: Advanced English and Public Health  
(State the class is Honors, both fall and spring)
- Advanced English and Public Health - Applied Medical English (State the class is Honors, both fall and spring)

( "In Progress" 1<sup>st</sup> semester and "Planned" 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (State the class is Honors in both the Fall and the Spring)

Science:

- If you're taking APES – AP Environmental Science (and state that the class is AP, both fall and spring),
- Biotechnology Accelerated & Research is Biotech 3,
- Mechatronics Engineering,
- Honors Anatomy
- Human Psychology

Math:

Math 2, Math 3, Mathematical Studies IB SL for Math Studies, AP Statistics (AP course), or AP Calculus AB (AP course)

Art: Follow the titles from your transcript.

College Prep Electives: Economics (2nd semester grade = "Planned", No 1st semester grade)

Also enter any other classes that didn't fit above (like AFAM studies, Computer Programming, Intro to Robotics)

If you took courses at Berkeley City College,

**SEI Classes**

*SEI-ELD 1-3 DOES NOT COUNT TOWARD COLLEGE*

*SEI-ExWriting (Expository Writing) and SEI-LitDiversity (Literature Diversity) count for college.*

*SEI-Composition is called Composition and SEI Writing is called Writing (Type In)*

***Do not apply for a FEE WAIVER or SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION until you meet with Ms. Navarro, Ms. Hammond, or Ms. Le in regards to your family income and mistakes on your application.***

#### **Exceptions**

**\*Use No Course if not taking the course either Fall or Spring Semester**

**\*Field Studies should be in Activity Section**

**\*2 years of middle school world language should be called Yr 1 Lang Other Than English in the 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade section**

**Use the following AMPS blurb for UC Applications in the additional comment box. The 2<sup>nd</sup> additional comment box allows for more characters (there is an additional comment box after you put in your grades and an additional comment box at the end of the application)**
