**BACKGROUND:** For many years, the Whole Earth Festival has been using a 24-foot trailer provided by Waste Busters, a local business. This trailer has in the past been provided free-of-charge out of support for the WEF community and is crucial for transferring the large amount of equipment between the Quad and WEF's off-campus storage unit. However, the business is now dissolving and the owner is offering to sell the trailer to WEF for \$8,000. Comparatively, the cost of procuring a similar trailer is between \$12,000 - \$20,000 (see [examples](#)) with delivery fees up to an additional \$5,000. If WEF is unable to purchase this trailer, festival staff will need to find alternative ways to move a large amount of equipment to and from the event.

WEF was budgeted \$12,000 for the Aggie Hosts Security throughout the weekend of the event. This year, the UC Davis Police Department and ASUCD have signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) agreement which waives the costs of having the Aggie Hosts present at this year's WEF. Following the prior transfer of \$2,000 from this line item into Chaos Control Foods, there is about \$10,000 remaining in the line item. WEF would like to use part of this money to instead procure the trailer for more permanent use.

Section 1. The ASUCD Senate hereby authorizes a transfer of \$8000.00 from the WEF SecurityAggieHost line item (8041961 53000) to the WEF Equipment Purchases line item (8041961 36000).
