#### Instructional Details and Global Collaboration

Students will choose a group of 4 students and a group #1-6. The students will then log into their Google Classroom and click on the assignment link for their group. Students will meet and discuss the topic of the story and the necessary details. The students will work the same on the same document to add the needed information to structure the story, then add narration and supporting picture of the story to the part they choose so that other collaborators understand how to add their parts to the story. When the groups have finished adding their parts students will notify the teacher by turning in the document. To follow district protocols, I am the one that will need to share their Collaborative Storytelling Document. I will post the shared links to the stories on Twitter mentioning several teachers that have collaborated with my students in the past from school districts in Colorado. I will also share the links with my school district's Google+ to invite district participation. I will also share with a member of this class Tara whom I know from the ISTE DSN and another teaching colleague that works with Tara, they both live in Dubai.

### Digital Citizenship Lesson

Students will learn about 5 elements of Digital Citizenship: Privacy, Cyberbullying, Creative Credit, Safe Searching, and appropriate Communication using Common Sense Media's Digital Passport. For each class session, students will participate in an introductory lesson, students will then take a topic quiz using a self-grading Google Form. If the student passes the quiz with an 80% or higher the student then completes the Digital Citizenship project which is a creation of a story or informational article that a reader can learn from the topic. If the student does not pass the topic guiz with 80% they will proceed to completing the DigtialPassport.org activities. These activities use videos and games to build student's understanding of the Digital Citizenship topic they did not pass the quiz. Then students will complete the project for the topic.
