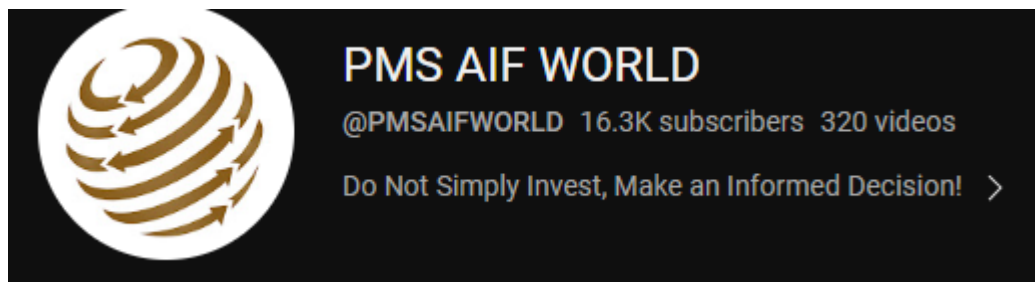


Hey,

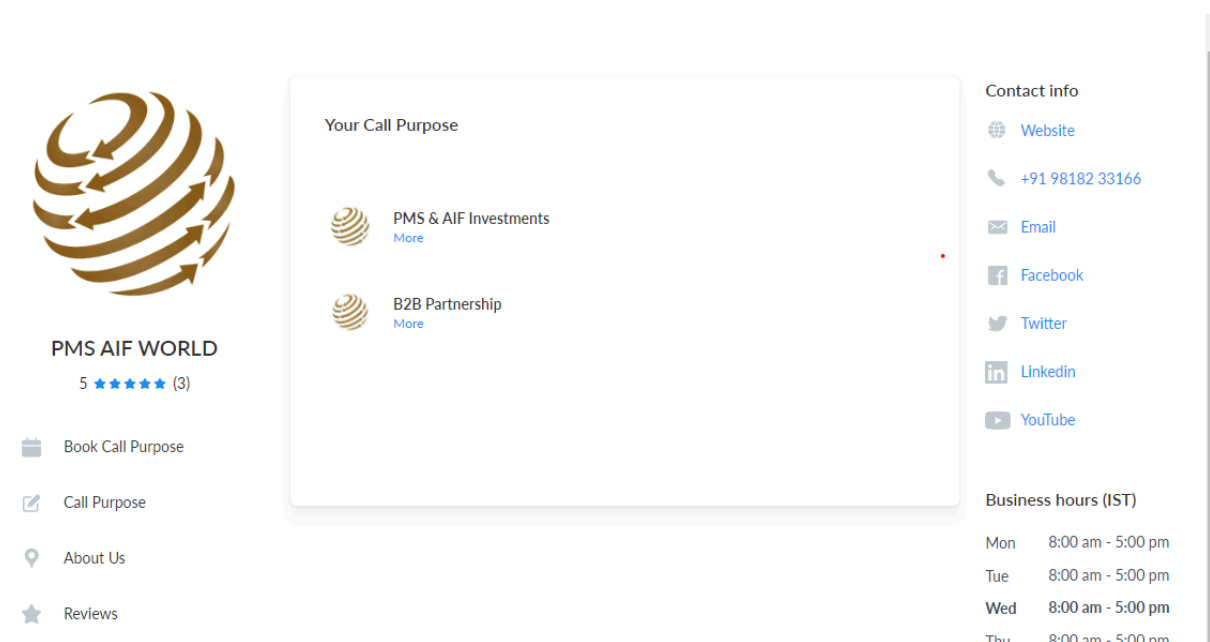
