
There are **three** tasks that you need to complete in order to take the course:

All three tasks must be completed by Friday, November 7, 2025



## **TASK #1: Dual Credit Application**

- 1. Go to <a href="https://www.hawaii.edu/dualcredit/">https://www.hawaii.edu/dualcredit/</a>
- 2. Choose "How to Apply"
- 3. Choose "Apply Now"
- 4. Choose "Spring 2026"
- Fill in all student information. For name, please do not use apostrophes, hyphenations or okina. For the student email question, please type in your personal email address, not your DOE email address.
- 6. For the question on class, please choose your grade class during the 2025-2026 school year
- 7. For Course, type in exactly **MATH100 MOA**. This is a 3 credit course. This will be a "HS Elective". Your program is "Early College". Your campus is "Leeward Community College".
- 8. Press the "Submit" button. You will then see your actual finished application.
- 9. It is time to print but instead of printing, choose "Save as PDF"
- 10. Send the PDF copy to me at <a href="mailto:ronald.ikari@k12.hi.us">ronald.ikari@k12.hi.us</a>.
- 11. I will send you a confirmation email after I have successfully received your PDF copy of your Dual Credit Application and we will move on to task #2. If you cannot save as a PDF, contact me and we will try it another way. Signatures will be done electronically, so along with your parents, please check your email accounts.



### TASK #2: Online Leeward Community College Application


- 1) If you are a continuing Early College student (taking LCC classes in Fall 2025 semester), **you do not have to do this task**. You are done. If you are **not** a continuing LCC student or if you took a break and skipped Fall 2025 semester, go on to step #2 below.
- 2) Go to <a href="https://star.hawaii.edu/shortapp/app/?campus=LEE&ProgramFilter=E">https://star.hawaii.edu/shortapp/app/?campus=LEE&ProgramFilter=E</a> arlyAdmit#/
- 3) Please accurately fill in questions. You may need parent/guardian help. For the student email question, please type in your **personal email address**, **not your DOE email address**.
- 4) Submit your application. You should **NOT** have to pay an application fee. If you do see a fee required, do not submit. After submission, you should immediately get an "application submitted" email from the UH system. If you don't get an email, please let me know.
- 5) You are done with task #2! Forward to me a copy of your "application submitted" email as proof that you have finished your application. I will send you a confirmation email acknowledging receipt.
- 6) You should be getting your acceptance email from the UH system in about 7-10 business days. Please follow the instructions on your acceptance email. You should receive your UH ID Number and steps on how to create your personal UH account and UH email.


### TASK #3: EdReady Placement Test

In order to complete this task, you must have received your acceptance email from LCC. It takes about 7-10 business days after you have submitted your UH Online Application. It should look something like this:



Please follow the instructions on your acceptance email. You should receive your UH ID Number and steps on how to create your personal UH account and UH email.

The Goal Key for Leeward CC is UH\_LEE\_Placement

The goal key is Case Sensitive, goal key needs to be capitalized and lowercased as presented with the underscores.

You will need to take the following test with the minimum score:

Math Path 1: Non-STEM/College Math. Score Needed: 72

Placement Into: Math 100, 111, 115, College Math

Please email me when you have completed task #3 with a passing score. If you do not pass with a score of at least 72, you will need to do a remedial session online and you can retake the assessment. Congratulations, you have completed the hard part of the process! There are just a few more easy things to do and I will help you with those things.
