




- Go to your course in Google Classroom at https://classroom.google.com
- 2. On the Classwork tab, click the Create button. Choose Assignment, Question, or Material based on what you plan to do with your lesson.




3. For whichever item you chose in Step 2, click Upload in your window. Find your video file and upload it to your course.



4. Browse for your file on your computer and upload.




5. You will see your video listed in your Assignment, Question, or Material after uploading.
