Uploading a Video to Google Classroom

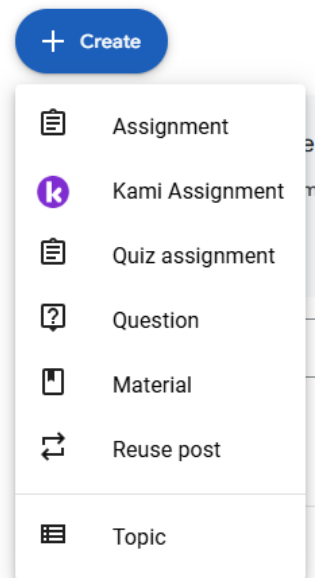
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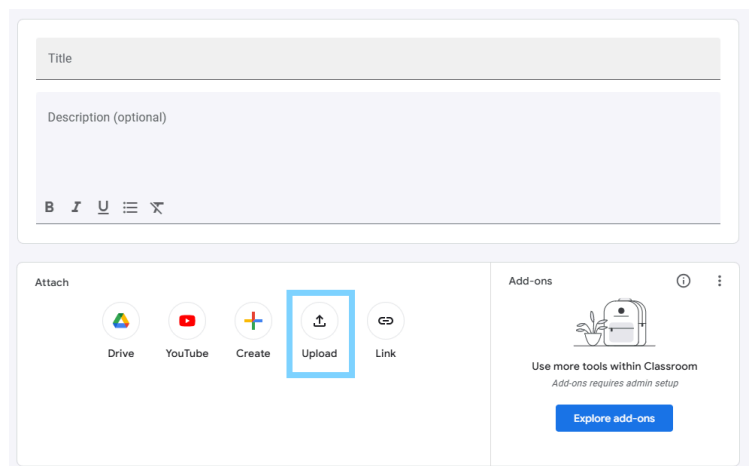
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1. Go to your course in Google Classroom at <https://classroom.google.com>

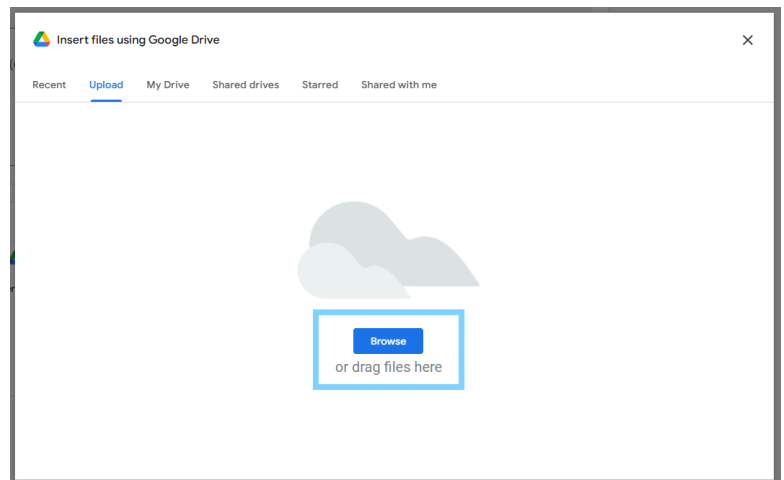
2. On the Classwork tab, click the Create button. Choose Assignment, Question, or Material based on what you plan to do with your lesson.



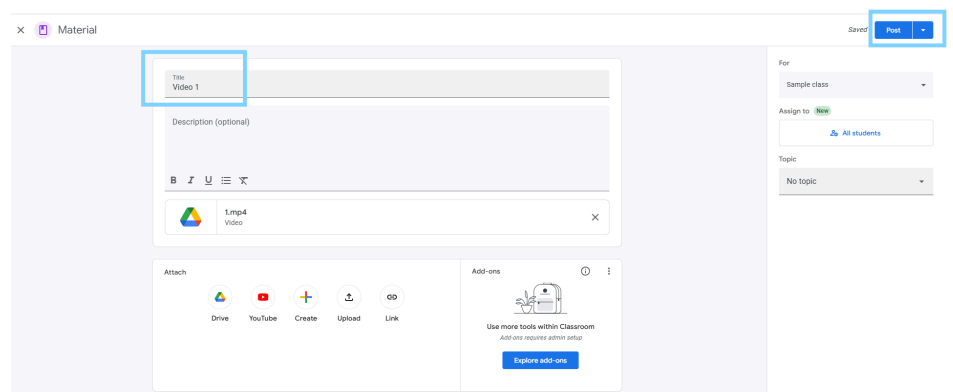
3. For whichever item you chose in Step 2, click Upload in your window. Find your video file and upload it to your course.



4. Browse for your file on your computer and upload.



5. You will see your video listed in your Assignment, Question, or Material after uploading.



Give your item a title, then click the Assign, Ask, or Post button, respectively.

6. Both the Student and Teacher View will display the video in the Classwork and Stream listings. Click on the video to view it.
