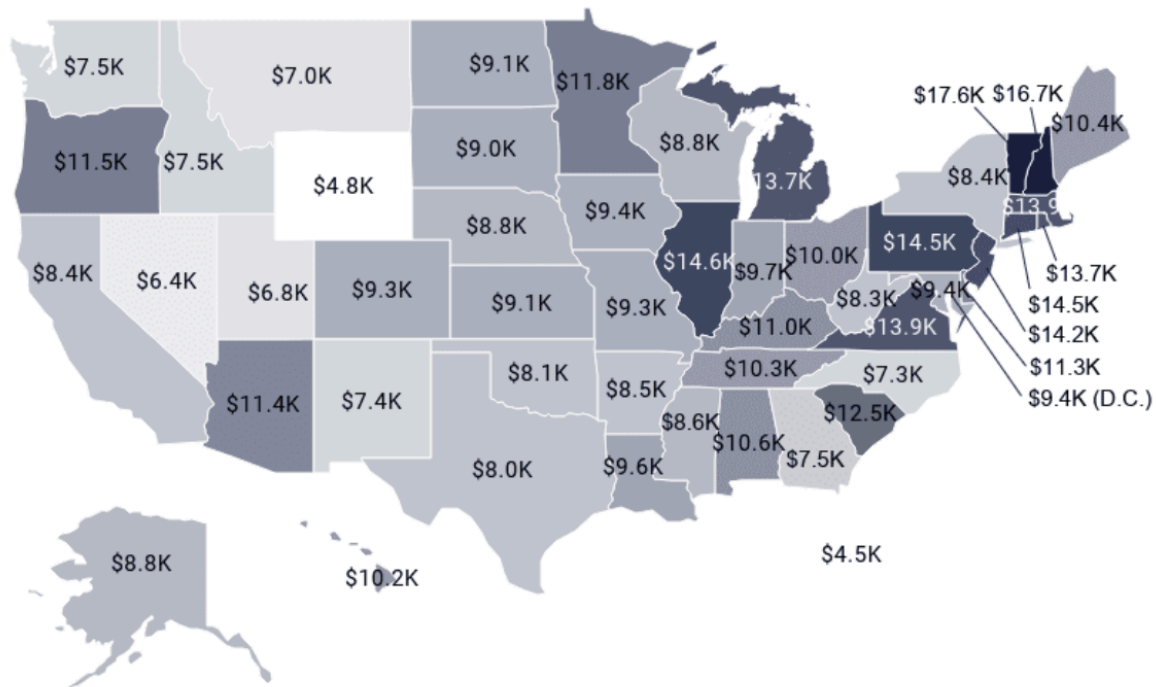

For Imani, use the Juris Doctor degree costs divided by 3 to get the annual cost.

Dual Enrollment Costs

Each state handles dual-enrollment courses and costs differently. Some states charge high school students nothing with those charges being covered by a taxpayer state fund. Some states charge per course, and others charge per credit hour. When students are researching their own expected costs, use the cost information provided by your state for the college(s) working with your school.

For Maria, use the cost of \$600 per year for her dual-enrollment tuition costs.
