

## GROUP ROLES and PRESENTATION OUTLINE

**LEAD PRESENTER** – This person starts and concludes the group presentation by introducing the group and explaining the theme/ area of the school that their sign represents.

For example – “Good afternoon. My name is \_\_\_\_\_ and my group has designed a sign for the Music area of our new school building. The members of my group are \_\_\_\_\_ (insert names of group members). \_\_\_\_\_ will begin by explaining the theme of our sign and explaining some of the symbols we chose to represent that theme.

**SYMBOL and QUOTE EXPERT** – [The symbol expert explains the symbols you have chosen to represent your theme on your sign. These symbols should be shown on your laser cutter sample or your poster. You should be able to explain why you chose these symbols to represent your subject area. Think about how you had to create that symbol on the software program before using the laser printer. You will also introduce your group’s favourite quote about your subject area.

**CONTENT SPECIALIST** – You will be assigned **ONE** of the five areas to become an expert on during your presentation –

LOGOS and BRANDS

THE DESIGN PROCESS

MATERIALS

THE CRITIQUE PROCESS (showing your multiple drafts)

ROLE OF THE ARCHITECT

**STRENGTHS and CHALLENGES EVALUATOR** – This group member will talk about how the group worked together as a team – not pointing out how individuals behaved, but focusing on how the group worked together overall. This presentation should include mention of teamwork, the critique process, brainstorming, sharing the work-load and presenting. Make sure you focus in on at least one strength and at least one challenge you faced, as a group.

**LEAD PRESENTER** – The lead presenter will also conclude the presentation by pointing out the specific part of the design that the group would really like to see in the final sign at their school. Consider mentioning that you are the founding members of the school and that you would like to leave a lasting **legacy** (a legacy is something left behind when you are gone to represent you). You might choose the quote or a particular symbol in your sign design that you would like to see on a final sign. Choose **ONE** part of your design that is most important and really sell it to the panel.

Finally, thank the panel for listening and considering your design.
