USE DESCRIPTIVE WORDS:
There was a **crusty old** sandwich.
The boy **sprinted so fast, no one could catch him.**

Use speech marks.
"Help me!" Cried Sarah.

FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE:
The watch glistened like the sun rising over the water.
