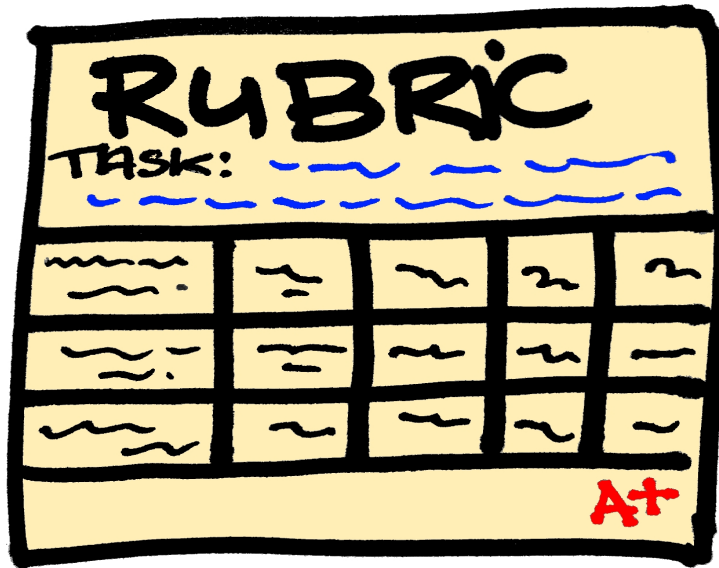


Building and Using Rubrics for Assessment

Overview

By using rubrics, teachers can streamline the grading process, making it more objective and efficient, while also promoting a more equitable learning environment where all students are assessed by the same standards.
