Description

This class course will examine the clothing industry and how it affects the world around us. We will examine the area of fashion design, fabric care, fabric choice, costs, types of fabric, elements of design, etc. The students will be required to complete a variety of sewing projects and be creating their own clothing line/designs.

3. How are clothing choices influenced by society?
4. How are equipment and tools used to create apparel and textile products?
5. How do properties of textiles and fabrics affect design, construction, care, use and maintenance of products?
6. How do you read and follow procedures when creating a textile or apparel product?
7. How can the alteration of or repair of textile or apparel products be a cost and earth friendly practice for consumers?
8. How do the techniques and principles learned in class apply to the creation of an individual, unique textile or apparel project?
