Water Polo Booster FAQs



1. What do the Water Polo Booster Clubs do?

The booster clubs support all team activities including handling payment for equipment, organizing travel and hotel stays, organizing and volunteering for the Ohio Cup tournament, payment for assistant coaches, referees, and planning awards and banquets.

2. How will the booster club fee & fundraising money be used?

The money will all be used for the water polo teams. Over the years, we've purchased new scoreboards and timers for the team to use during the Ohio Cup. Other costs include equipment like balls, swim caps & headgear, assistant coach salaries, cost of officials, etc.

3. What other money am I responsible to pay for?

The booster club will book and submit payment for team hotels in order to get the best rates, as we are a tax-exempt organization. Athletes will share rooms, and we ask parents to cover most of those costs. In some cases, the booster club absorbed the hotel costs for travel to JV States and North Region action and for State Tournament.

4. How else can parents support the water polo teams?

Water polo relies on robust parent support. As part of the team, you will be asked to help with carpooling transportation to get the players to the out-of-town tournaments. You'll be able to sign up for these online. Your help will also be critical on our Ohio Cup weekends. The boys & girls tournaments are over two weekends in September. The event is a premier event hosted by the TWHS and WKHS teams and their booster clubs. You'll be asked to spend time timing, scoring, taking tickets, or selling concessions.

5. Do the high school booster teams work together?

While the TWHS & WKHS Water Polo booster organizations are separate entities, they do work together in some cases. For example, both groups help organize and supply volunteers for the Boys & Girls Ohio Cup. Also, since the boys and girls usually travel to different tournaments – the WKHS boosters book girls' hotels & TWHS book boys' hotels. Both groups work together to determine costs & make sure expenses are covered equally between the high schools.
