#### ABSTRACT

Authors are required to provide a well-structured abstract for their submission, encompassing the following elements: Purpose, Design/methods/approach, Findings/results, and Conclusions. The abstract should not exceed a maximum of 300 words, excluding keywords.

## INTRODUCTION (Times New Roman, 14pt, Bold)

The introduction of a journal article serves to explain the study's purpose and rationale. The introduction should be clear and accessible to informed readers, while setting the stage for the main sections of the article. Write in a way that makes the reader wants to read further, the purpose should be stated clearly so that the readers know whether it is relevant to them or not.

Author(s) should also present a clear "state of the art" of the subject, which discussed literature and theoretical concepts behind it. A concise general background may be included in the article. Present at least 3 (three) recent related works to support the novelty of the research.

Although writing compelling manuscript is a must, please make sure the article adheres to the specified formatting guidelines, such as using "Times New Roman" font size 12 and maintaining a spacing of 1.5. Additionally, as the article is published in English Education: Jurnal Tadris Bahasa Inggris, make sure to write in English and follow the stated requirements.

The article must be of 10-15 pages long and is submitted in editable text format, preferably OpenDocument Text (.odt) to ensure the the compatibility between reviewers, authors and editors. However, the use Office Open XML (.docx), is more than acceptable. Although it should be avoided due to the age and proprietary nature of it, English Education: Jurnal Tadris Bahasa Inggris still accepts Microsoft Words 97-2003 Binary File (.doc). The use of other formats, especially portable formats such as Portable Document File (.pdf) will result in rejection. A maximum of 10 (ten) words must be used as the title of the article.

Authors must guarantee that their article is free from plagiarism. The accepted rate of similarity is 20%, checked with Turnitin or similar tools such as Grammarly. However, if a manuscript presents plagiarism rate less than 25%, English Education: Jurnal Tadris Bahasa Inggris will not outright reject it and will contact the corresponding author for re-submission after revision. Article that has been submitted or published elsewhere cannot be submitted.

Third level heading follows the style of the second level heading. Avoid the use of headings that have more than three levels.

Use reference manager such as Zotero, Mendeley or EndNote in citing works of others. If author(s) don't use the any reference manager, it will only make the review and editorial time longer. Use the APA 6th style. English Education: Jurnal Tadris Bahasa Inggris highly recommends the use of Zotero. Its open-source nature is in spirit with our goal to provide freedom to masses, compared to other managers, Zotero is not only free as in 'free speech', author(s) are not required to make any account and local backup can be easily done without any need of other softwares and clouds. English Education: Jurnal Tadris Bahasa Inggris also prepared a guide to use Zotero, feel free to download, use, and distribute it.

This section is organized systematically, and only the related results or information of the research should be discussed here.

### ***Findings (Second Level Heading, Times New Roman, 12pt, Bold-italic)***

This sub section should be written in capital letter in the first letter, 12pt, bold and italic. This sub section displays the data or information obtained through the correct procedure of the aforementioned research method. The findings also should answer the research question(s) stated.

The table (if any) is displayed using open table and the title of the table should be written in Times New Roman, 12pt, sentence case. There should not be vertical lines and horizontal lines are allowed if needed. Paragraph spacing of the table should be in one space.

All Figures should be of high quality, legible and numbered consecutively with Arabic numerals. Graphics may be supplied in colour to facilitate their appearance on the online database.

***Discussion (Second Level Heading, Times New Roman, 12pt, Bold-italic)***

This sub section also should be written in capital letter in the first letter, 12pt, bold and italic. This sub section discusses the interpretation and the implication of findings and their relations to the theories or previous findings.

**CONCLUSION (Times New Roman, 14pt, Bold)**

The conclusion should be linked to the title and objectives of the study. Do not make statements not adequately supported by your findings. Write the improvements made to English education, literature or education in general. Do not make further discussions, repeat the abstract, nor only list the results of research results. Do not use bulleted points, use paragraphed sentences instead.

This template is prepared so that all articles published in English Education: Jurnal Tadris Bahasa Inggris will have a consistent format. Authors must follow this template.

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT (if any (Times New Roman, 14pt, Bold))**

Those who contribute but do not meet all criteria for authorship should not be listed as authors, but they should be acknowledged at the end of the text. Only the names of the persons but not their role should be written under acknowledgement section. Authors must

declare all sources of external research funding in their article and a statement to this effect should appear in the Acknowledgements section.

## **REFERENCES (Times New Roman, 14pt, Bold)**

English Education: Jurnal Tadris Bahasa Inggris prefers **articles which refer mainly to journal articles, research reports, and conference proceedings**, rather than rely heavily on textbooks or handbooks to demonstrate articles' novelty in the subject discussed. The use of Zotero as a tool in referencing is preferable and encouraged. References should be carefully checked for completeness, accuracy, and consistency.
