

How To Download Stardict Sanskrit Dictionaries And Set It Up In ColorDict App

Steps:

1. Install "ColorDict" App from playstore.
2. Click On Folder Icon. Its found in the top right corner, beside the menu icon.
3. Click on the Download icon present in the top right corner, beside the menu icon.
4. Note the default folder where all the dictionary files must be placed. It will be like
Data folder : /storage/emulated/0/Android/media/
com.socialnmobile.colordict/dictdata
5. The dictionary files can be downloaded using "Stardict Dictionary Update"app.
6. After opening the app, selecting the dictionaries required and clicking on "Proceed" button, it will ask you to select the folder where the dictionary files must be downloaded. Give the folder path that you noted in the Step 4 above.
7. In case you have dictionary files already downloaded in some local folders, copy those files to the folder noted in Step 4.
8. Remember that for a particular dictionary to be recognised and indexed by ColorDict app, the following 3 files must be there together ".dict.dz" , ".idx" and ".ifo".
9. Once done the ColorDict will auto recognise the Dictionaries. It will index it and makes it ready to use.
10. If there is a version of ColorDict already in your phone, then better uninstall and reinstall if facing any issues.

This is based on my personal experience. Hope the users may find it useful .
