How to Apply for RIVEROAK Technical College's Postsecondary Education Scholarship

1. Complete a RTC Career Certificate Scholarship application. Copies may be obtained from RTC or High School Guidance Office.
2. Include a personal introduction letter (letter detailing information about your background, achievements, short-term & long-term goals and why you need and/or deserve a scholarship.) Letter should be NO more than 2 pages doubled spaced.
3. Provide letter of recommendation from one instructor.
4. Complete a Free Application Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the Fall Term.
5. Student should be a **current Senior from Branford High School, Columbia High School, Ft. White High School, Hamilton County High School, Lafayette High School, Madison County High School, Suwannee High School or a Private School/Home School in Suwannee County.**
6. Scholarships will be awarded in two scholarship amounts during one academic year. Once a student is selected and he or she successfully enrolls in classes, \$500 will be awarded at the beginning of the Fall Term. Upon completion of Fall Term, with student maintaining a GPA of 3.0 or better, the second payment of \$500 will be awarded for the Spring Term.
