  - Planning course selection really does matter what STs sign up for in Feb does matter to what we offer and # of sections we form

- PR: Similar to goals from last year
  - There may be changes to these drafted goals once new principal is onboarded, but wanted to move forward with this as it's something we're working on this semester and Fall of next year
  - Looking for feedback; have gotten feedback from Curricular Leader
- PR: When doing data diving, we noticed a drop in ST taking the CAASPP
  - This can be impacting some of our data (accuracy)
- Q (ST): What is Tier 1?
  - It can be helpful to all STs
  - In class supports

  - From a lot of the various data we've looked
  - The goals are essentially a roll over from last year, but there have been adjustments to strategies

  - State will now "ding" school if participation is under 95%
  - School will share info families
  - The opt out process has changed this year
- Staff can share the impact on taking the test, but comments must stay neutral
