## A-Engrossed Senate Bill 732

Ordered by the Senate April 30 Including Senate Amendments dated April 30

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires school districts to establish educational equity advisory committee. Prescribes duties and membership of committees.

Takes effect July 1, 2022.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to educational equity advisory committees; creating new provisions; amending ORS 328.542 2 and 329.095; and prescribing an effective date. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 329. 5 SECTION 2. (1) Nothing in this section shall interfere with the duties, responsibilities and 6 rights of duly elected school district boards. There shall be established at each school district 7 an educational equity advisory committee. 8 (2) The duties of an educational equity advisory committee shall include:

(a) Advising the school district board about the educational equity impacts of policy de 10 cisions;

(b) Advising the school district superintendent about the educational equity impacts of 12 policy decisions; and

- (c) Informing the school district board and school district superintendent when a situ 14 ation arises in a school of the school district that negatively impacts underrepresented stu 15 dents and advising the board and superintendent on how best to handle that situation. 16
  - (3) The educational equity advisory committee may prepare an annual report that: 17
