About the performance

Garden Party combines immersive theatre and an art installation. It invites visitors to join a shared feast while bringing the spirits of the past to life.

The event takes place outdoors in **Kraffer Garden**. Throughout the experience, you move around the garden and, in some parts, you have the opportunity to sit down.

At the entrance to the garden, South Bohemian Theatre ushers will welcome you and check your ticket before the experience begins.

Duration: 90 minutes, without an interval

Key accessibility information

Format: Immersive installation

Duration: 90 minutes, without an interval

Capacity: Maximum 65 visitors

Performance space: Outdoors

Mobility: You spend most of the experience moving around the garden. Seating is available in some parts of the installation. The garden has several levels, open greenhouses, garden paths, steps and an alternative sloping route.

Language: Czech

Sensory information: Sound. No strobe lighting or other strong visual effects are used.

Content: The past, a feast, stories, conflict, foretelling, beings and encounters.

Getting there

By car

The performance takes place in **Kraffer Garden**, located at:

377 01 Jindřichův Hradec II

You can drive from České Budějovice to Jindřichův Hradec in **under 50 minutes** via Road No. 34 towards Třeboň. At the roundabout in Třeboň, take the **second exit** onto Road **E551**, which leads directly to Jindřichův Hradec.

Parking

The nearest **free** parking is at **Röschova Car Park**.

This car park is located on the edge of the town and offers designated parking spaces for Blue Badge holders.

From the car park, you can walk to Kraffer Garden.

Another option is the **Miřiovského Car Park**.

This is a spacious paid car park in Jindřichův Hradec.

Parking costs **CZK 10 per day**. Charges apply on weekdays from **6:30 am to 6:00 pm** and on Saturdays from **7:00 am to 12:00 pm**. Parking is free on Sundays and public holidays.

The car park is approximately **360 metres** from Kraffer Garden.

By train

Direct train services run between České Budějovice and Jindřichův Hradec. The journey takes **just under one hour**.

By coach

Direct coach services also run between České Budějovice and Jindřichův Hradec. The journey takes approximately **one hour**.

By local bus

You can also reach Kraffer Garden from the railway or bus station using local bus services.

Routes: 61, 62, 65 and 71

The journey takes approximately **10 minutes**.

Venue

The performance takes place in **Kraffer Garden** in Jindřichův Hradec.

Kraffer Garden is a model natural garden where flowers are grown and which also hosts a variety of cultural and environmental events.

Arriving at the venue

The entrance to Kraffer Garden is from **Pražská Street**.

The entrance is step-free. It is located directly beside a busy road with regular traffic.

Dropped kerbs provide step-free access from the road to the paved pavement.

The main entrance is set within a high historic wall and consists of large wooden gates opening directly onto Pražská Street.

A standard paved city pavement runs alongside the entire perimeter wall. The entrance surface is made of traditional stone paving, which continues through the entrance into the garden.

The transition from the pavement into the garden is smooth.

What to expect on arrival

A South Bohemian Theatre usher will welcome you at the entrance and check your ticket.

If you have any questions or need assistance, you can ask a member of staff.

There is **no cloakroom** where you can leave coats or bags.

During the performance

You spend most of the performance moving around the extensive Baroque garden.

In some parts of the performance, seating is available.

There is **no tactile guiding path**.

The garden is step-free throughout.

The performance is suitable for **wheelchair users**, although we recommend attending with a companion. In some areas, you may need to use an alternative route.

Sensory information

During the performance, you may encounter:

- various sound sources.

No smoke effects, strobe lighting or other strong sensory effects are used.

Toilets

A portable toilet is located near the entrance.

The toilet is **not wheelchair accessible**.

Leaving the venue

The performance is expected to finish at approximately **10:00 pm**.

There are no overnight local bus services in Jindřichův Hradec. Local bus services usually operate until **9:00–10:30 pm**, depending on the route.

If you are returning to the railway or bus station, please allow approximately **10–15 minutes** for the walk.

If you need assistance finding your way back to the main entrance, please ask a member of the theatre staff.
