Status: Due to overwhelming demand I take the commissions that I find personally appealing. If you have something you'd like to pitch you can leave it on my <u>Discord</u>.

Notes on Price

These are base prices. Please be aware that I have to reserve the right to ask for additional funds for detailed backgrounds, characters, or a larger amount of characters.

The Process

- 1) At this time Patreon keeps me very busy. Commission requests are fine during streams. If I have time I'll usually do them same-day.
- 2) You can get notified when I'm live by following here.

On Comics

I have temporarily stopped taking *detailed* comic scripts from clients. There is far too much headache and indecision involved. Trust me when I say it is better this way. Clients should be aware of the amount of freedom required to make an idea work in comic form. You are free to request a comic of up to 3 pages with up to 100 words of notes per page. More than that is outside the scope of a simple commission.

Wing-It: You choose the character design and whether it's safe for work, I choose the pose, the angle, and the cropping (may not be full body). In moderate resolution (2K).

Commission: Take the director's seat. Give me as few or as many notes as you need. If the sketch isn't to your specifications you can make minor adjustments. In high resolution (3-4K).

*: Detailed backgrounds or multiple characters may increase the base price by \$50 per element.

Comic Page: The format works best for longer stories or dialog driven plot and accommodates anywhere from 3-6 panels per page without clutter. In high resolution (3-4K).

Character Reference: An easy to read front and back pose, along with 3 panels that can be used for facial expressions, special clothing, or accessories. In high resolution (3-4K).
